

The Governing Regulations of the Seattle Summer Swim League

Article I

Name

Seattle Summer Swim League

Article II

Objects and Purposes

Section 1

The object and purpose of this league shall be to provide an opportunity for member clubs to participate in recreational and competitive swimming.

Article III

Membership

Section 1

Membership Eligibility and Applications:

Applications from prospective member organizations will be received by the Board of Directors, in writing, from clubs operating only a summer competitive swimming program. Such applications will be acted upon by the general membership at the regular Spring meeting.

Section 2

Dues

Dues shall be based on the annual operating expenses.

Section 3

Voting

Each member club present at meetings shall have one (1) vote.

Article IV

Meeting and Elections

Section 1

Meetings

- a) The annual meeting will be held on the second Thursday in March. Only members in good standing (current dues paid up) shall be permitted to attend upon any business at this meeting. Election of board members will take place at this meeting. The board shall present to the member clubs the proposed Operating Plan and By-Laws for the coming year for member approval.
- b) Special meetings may be called by the majority of the Board of Directors upon written notification of all members of the league at least one week in advance of the meeting.
- c) Protest meetings will be called by the President by written notification or telephone call of all the members of the league. When a written protest has been received by the President within two days after a meet or incident, the meeting will be held within five days of the filing of the protest. The members present at the protest meeting will constitute a quorum.

Section 2

Transaction of Business

At any Annual or Spring meeting of the League, any business may be transacted. At any special meeting the nature of the business to be transacted shall be limited to that specified in the call of such a meeting.

Section 3

Elections

The Board of Directors of the League shall consist of six members, not more than four members of whom shall be pool managers or other employees. Board members shall be elected for two year terms. Members are eligible for re-election. At least one member shall be from each division. Officers shall consist of president, vice-president, secretary, and treasurer; and shall be elected by the members of the board.

Article V

Duties of the Officers

Section 1

President

The President shall preside at all the meetings and shall perform all such duties incidental to that office.

Section 2

Vice-President

The Vice-President shall assist the President and in the absence of the latter shall exercise the duties of the President and shall act as coordinator of all committees and their activities.

Section 3

Secretary

The Secretary shall keep a record of the League and the board meetings, if any, and shall perform such duties as may be designated that office by the President.

Section 4

Treasurer

- a) The Treasurer shall keep an accurate written report and record of all monies of which he or she is to be custodian.
- b) The Treasurer shall keep an account and present it at each regular meeting.
- c) The Treasurer is responsible for procuring all League championship awards.

Article VI

Amendments

Section 1

An amendment to these articles shall consist of a two-thirds vote of the members.
